## **ABOUT US**

- Every dollar donated to Lakeview Pantry allows us to provide approximately 10 pounds of food to our neighbors in need. The USDA calculates that 1.2 pounds is an average meal (determined of course by age and appetite of individuals).
- Last year, the Pantry fed 8,200 individuals who visited the Pantry a total of 40,000 times. Of these, about 260 are Home Delivery clients who receive Pantry deliveries approximately 2,000 times over one year.
- Last year, we distributed 1.3 million meals 800 tons of food.
- We offer shelf stable groceries, dairy and eggs, protein such as chicken, beef and fish, and fresh fruits and vegetables – and everyone who visits is offered flowers – they're donated by Trader Joe's!
- Our food distribution model is what is referred to as "client choice" where clients choose from our nutritionally balanced menu which items they wish to receive.
- We also offer a program of social services to our clients, which includes help with healthcare, housing and other benefit forms, help with employment, and one to one counseling.
